We are seeking a suitably qualified person to commence early in 2022 who wishes to make a difference in the lives of students aged between 18 and 23 years, who predominantly attend ANU, although we also support students from other Canberra based tertiary institutions in an undergraduate setting.

The DHoC is an Executive Position within John XXIII College. The DHoC oversees all aspects of student life in the College as well as playing a key role in supporting relationships with staff, alumni and the broader community. The DHoC reports directly to the Head of College. It is essential for the DHoC to be actively engaged in supporting the ongoing strategic direction that the College undertakes. They will also aspire to act out the College values in all daily interactions.

The DHoC will lead a strong student services staff team, focused on academic and pastoral support, whilst working closely with student leaders to continue to embed a culture of inclusivity, diversity and care. It is important to note that the position comes with a College Residence and therefore involves flexible hours since the effective operation of the College necessitates evening and weekend on-call responsibilities as a part of a rostered staff team.

The College is completing a large-scale building program as a part of the Master Plan and has just completed the Strategic Planning 2026 process which was inclusive of a broad range of stakeholders and implemented by the College Board.
